

BACHELOR – application to enrollment

Requirement: Matura, vocational matura or final examination after the completion of 4-year secondary education programme or equivalent in Slovenia or abroad.

PROOF OF ARTISTIC ABILITY:

- 1. Folder:**
 - Portfolio
 - Motivation letter with a biography
- 2. Assignment**
 - Candidates with a positively evaluated portfolio receive a special creative task. If the assignment is positively evaluated, s_he will be invited to an interview.
- 3. Interview**

The folder should be submitted to admission.au@ung.si. All communication for proof of artistic ability will be conducted through this email address.



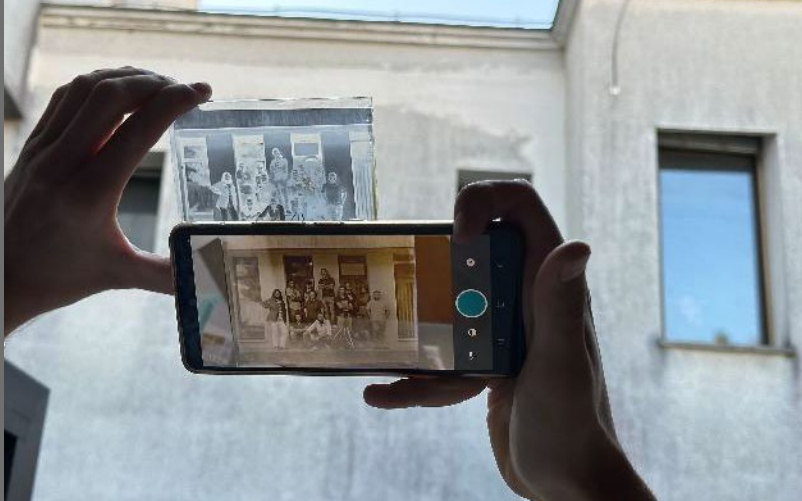
How do I build a FOLDER?

Combine all parts of the folder into one pdf, which should also be properly formatted/designed and contain everything necessary:

- 1/ **COVER** with your name & surname, possibly some visuals
- 2/ **INDEX**, which will guide the commission so that it does not overlook anything
- 3/ a comprehensive **BIOGRAPHY** that will introduce you in the creative sector, as well as your activities outside of it
- 4/ **MOTIVATION LETTER**, where you present to us what you expect from your studies and where you see yourself after it
- 5/ **PORTFOLIO**

IMPORTANT: file names (of the pdf and any video materials) should not contain (ščž,< or other) special characters!





How to - PORTFOLIO?

5/ PORTFOLIO

a) **LIST OF WORKS**, which are then presented in order across the following pages. Please note: each work should include, next to the title, some basic information, such as:

- year of creation, medium, etc.
- information on whether the work is your individual project or a group project (in the latter case, list the team members and clearly define your role), or whether it is a school production (in that case, add information about the school, mentor(s), and any collaborating classmates/colleagues).
- we also recommend adding a few words about the context in which the work was created or about its content.

b) **WORKS**, in the same order as listed. If the work is a video medium, include several still images from each piece in the PDF, along with information about its duration and production; the actual video or a link to it should be added as an attachment>

c) **ATTACHMENT** with video works or links to them should be provided outside the PDF; do not attempt to embed them within the PDF.

Application to enrollment timeline 2026

Submission for EU citizens* or have a permanent residence in the Republic of Slovenia:

- **1st round:** from 18 February until 18 March
- **2nd round:** from 21 August until 27 August
- ***Last round:** from 23 September until 24 September (until 10 am)

Submission deadlines for other candidates:

- **1st round :** from 18 February until 18 March
- **2nd round:** from 1 April until 1 July
- **3rd round:** from 1 August until 1 September
- ***Last round:** from 10 September until 24 September
