



Based on the financial plan for the Across project, the University of Nova Gorica (hereinafter "UNG") announces

Call for Events of Graduate School - Mobility within the Across Alliance for the 2026 Calendar Year

The Across Alliance offers students, researchers, and the general public opportunities for international collaboration and mobility, a jointly enriched academic program, and access to high-quality research equipment.

This call for applications is open to UNG students (at the master's and doctoral levels¹) wishing to participate in various events organized by the Across Graduate School (doctoral schools, workshops, training sessions, hackathons, joint courses, etc.) held at other universities within the Across alliance.

In addition to UNG, the Across alliance includes the following member universities:

Mobility activities must be related to one of the four Across focus areas:

- 1) Education in cross-border contexts,
- 2) Culture, language, identity, and heritage,
- 3) Economic, public policy, and social development,
- 4) Management of natural resources

The total indicative budget available under this call for 2026 is 3,000 EUR.

If the available funds are exhausted before the end of the respective application deadline, the call will be closed early.

I. BASIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

Under this call, candidates (master's and doctoral students at UNG) may submit proposals for mobility activities to be carried out during the 2026 calendar year (through December 31, 2026).

II. DURATION OF THE MOBILITY

The call covers mobility activities lasting **3 to 5 days**. Travel time is not included in the duration of the mobility activity.

Master's level: Master's degree programme; unified Master's degree programme

Doctoral level: doctoral programme





III. REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES

Under this call, the selected mobility candidate is eligible for reimbursement of accommodation and travel expenses.

The maximum reimbursement amount for each mobility activity is **720 EUR**.

Reimbursement of costs for UNG employees is carried out in accordance with the Rules on the reimbursement of commuting costs, meal allowances, and the calculation and payment of business travel expenses:

Reimbursements to students are made on a contract basis. The indicative amounts used to calculate reimbursements are based on the Erasmus+ mobility call for proposals and are as follows:

Accommodation expenses:

| Group | Funds per day | Countries |
|----------------------------|---------------|---|
| Group 1 – highest standard | 190 EUR/day | France, Germany, Italy |
| Group 2 – medium standard | 170 EUR/day | Spain |
| Group 3 – lower standard | 148 EUR/day | Bulgaria, Poland, Romania, Bosnia and Herzegovina |

Travel expenses:

| Distance | Standard trip | Green trip |
|------------------|---------------|--------------------------------------|
| 10 km - 99 km | 28 EUR | 56 EUR* + up to 6 days for the trip |
| 100 km - 499 km | 211 EUR | 285 EUR* + up to 6 days for the trip |
| 500 km - 1999 km | 309 EUR | 417 EUR + up to 6 days for the trip |

*For distances of less than 500 km, participants generally use low-emission means of transport

The following are considered green travel options: travel by train, bus, car (van) via carpooling, bicycle, walking, electric scooter... The [Erasmus distance calculator](#) is used to calculate the distance. The starting point is always the UNG headquarters (Rožna Dolina).

IV. APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND DEADLINE

Applicants wishing to apply for this call must submit the following:

- the application form attached to this call,
- proof of registration for the doctoral school event.

Applications must be submitted electronically to: across@ung.si.

In 2026, there are two application deadlines:

1. deadline: **May 13, 2026**
2. deadline: **August 30, 2026**

An application is considered timely if it is received at the designated email address by the end of the respective application deadline, i.e., by 11:59 p.m. on the deadline date.

V. SELECTION PROCESS

The UNG office Across will open the applications, verify compliance with the basic eligibility requirements for the call for applications, and conduct a formal review of the applications. Applications that do not include all required attachments will be rejected. Applications received after the respective application deadline will be considered in the next application round, except for those received after the final application deadline, which will be rejected.



Formally complete applications will be reviewed by the selection committee appointed by the UNG Rector.

The selection committee reserves the right to transfer individual unselected applications to other open Across calls for mobilities, and will notify applicants in a timely manner via the email address provided in the application.

VI. EVALUATION CRITERIA AND SCORING

1. Encouraging Participation:
The number of times a participant attends graduate school events from 2026 onward will be evaluated as follows:
 - first attendance: 10 points
 - second attendance: 5 points
 - third attendance: 2 points
 - fourth and subsequent attendances: 0 points
2. Encouraging student participation at lower levels of education:
 - Master's program: 5 points
 - Doctoral program: 3 points
3. Encouraging active participation in events:
 - Participation in an event with an individual presentation: 10 points
 - Participation in an ECTS-accredited event: 7 points
 - Participation in an event as part of a panel: 5 points
 - Participation in an event, workshop, or hackathon: 3 points

If the number of applications exceeds the available funding, the committee will draw up a list of candidates for funding allocation in order of the points they have earned. Among applications with the same score, priority will be given to those with a higher score based on the first criterion (Encouraging Participation). If it is still not possible to determine which of the evaluated applications is selected, the application with the higher score based on the second criterion (Encouraging student participation at lower levels of education) will be selected.

Applicants will be notified of whether or not they have been awarded mobility funding within 10 business days after the respective application deadline, via the email address they provided in their application. The committee's decision is final.
