- obtaining residence permits, registering residence, citizenship,
- procedures for the birth of a child, marriage registration,
- driving license replacement,
- right and access to medical services,
- assistance available at social work,
- enrolling children in kindergartens and schools,
- free Slovenian language courses and taking the proficiency exam,
- opportunities for inclusion in various support programs in the local community.

We also organise free group training sessions and workshops on topics related to life in Slovenia.

From time to time, we will also organise intercultural educational and social events aimed at intercultural dialogue and mutual understanding.
