Prof. Bergman is a head of the Department of Environmental Chemistry at Stockholm University. His present research activities are best seen as presented at their website (www.miljokemi.su.se). In brief, his research projects in the field of organic environmental chemistry include i: synthesis of standard and test compounds of environmental concern, including metabolites of these compounds and radio-labelled substances; ii: development of analytical methods for and analysis of organic substances in environmental samples (primarily in biota); iii: exposure assessments in humans and wildlife; iv: metabolism studies (kinetics) of environmental pollutants; v: development of a new operational concept of persistency; and vi: contributions to risk assessment of chemicals.

This lecture is also a part of Global Environmental Health Course at the University of Iowa, USA. It will be held via the Elluminate Live web conferencing program.
