The work will take place in the [Laboratory for Environmental and Life Sciences](#), in the field of molecular/cell biology, biotechnology and antimicrobial activity. The selected candidate will also take on teaching responsibilities in the fields of molecular biology and biotechnology in one or more study programs at the university.

Candidates are expected to:

- hold a PhD in molecular/cell biology, microbiology or similar fields,
- have a good command of the English language,
- preferably have research experience abroad (1 year or longer).

The selection procedure will take into account theoretical knowledge and practical experience in one or more of the following fields: biotechnology, molecular and cell biology, biochemistry, flow cytometry and microbiology, analytical instrumental techniques (as evidenced by the bibliography of relevant scientific articles in international journals).

The position will be available as soon as the selection process is completed and no later than **1 December 2021**. Selected candidate will be appointed on a full-time basis for 12 months, with a possible extension of the contract.
